# Aldergrove Regional Park

The lower plateau of Aldergrove Regional Park has had invasive blackberry bushes removed and replaced with 1,676 native trees and plants.

## Kanaka Creek Regional Park

638 native plants have replenished forests at Kanaka Creek Regional Park, providing a healthy habitat for the wildlife that depends on it.

# Pacific Spirit Regional Park

A pollinator meadow consisting of Mountain Bromegrass, Slender Wheatgrass, Blue Flax, Woolley Sunflower, Pearly Everlasting, Farewell to Spring and Henderson's Shooting star has been planted at Pacific Spirit Regional Park.







# **Tynehead Regional Park**

168 native plants have found their new home at Tynehead Regional Park.

### Brunette-Fraser Regional Greenway

24 trees and 823 native plants are benefitting the environment at Brunette-Fraser Regional Greenway.

## **Crippen Regional Park**

900 trees and other native plants were placed in areas that needed rehabilitation and don't grow as fast naturally due to human (and beaver!) activity.
